Sample Script for Asking for Donations:

Hello, I am participating in a fundraiser to help Montgomery County Children. It will be a Puzzle-A-Thon, where I compete against other people to see who can put the most puzzle pieces together in the time allowed. This event will be held on **March 20th** from 1 to 5PM at the RE/MAX Building in Olney. It is a fundraiser to benefit, both, the Collaboration Council, a nonprofit organization that helps children, youth and families in Montgomery County; and Project Change, a local nonprofit serving youth in the greater Olney area. The Collaboration Council is a 501(c)(3) organization with 92% of it's money going directly to fund services for children. The Collaboration Council funds services for at risk youth and teens, after school programs for low income families, an emergency fund for families that have a child with a disability and many other projects.

With community help, I am hoping to raise at least \$100.00 through tax deductible donations of \$10,\$15, \$25,\$50, or whatever you feel you can afford.

Your tax deductible donation would help families in our community. Any amount will help. Cash donations are welcome;

Checks should be made payable to the “Collaboration Council”. If you would like a receipt for your donation, please include your address on the donation form. All donations are tax-deductible as permitted by law.
